- Assist with training Lift Attendants to operate the lifts and perform routine checks
- Operate company equipment safely and effectively in accordance with company policies
- Ensure compliance with local and national standards and legislation including the z-98 code and manufacturer's specifications.
- Keep work area safe and clean and report any damage, malfunction, misuse or abuse of any equipment or property.
